WHEREAS, late last night, or early this morning, the
City of Halifax, was destroyed by the explosion of the
Gunpowder stored therein, causing the destruction of
human life, and great injury to public and private property and alarm to the inhabitants of the City; and
whereas there is reason to believe that the same resulted from the wilful and malicious act of some person or
persons unknown; I do hereby offer and proclaim a Reward of

## FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS,

Currency to be paid to any person or persons (not concerned in the commission of the crime) who shall cause to be discovered or apprehended and brought to justice the offenders or any of them, upon conviction.

And all Her Majesty's loyal subjects are hereby enjoined and requested to aid in the premises to the utmost extent of their ability, and to disclose to the nearest Magistrate, or to His Worship the Mayor of Halifax, any information they may possess or receive in relation to the subject.
