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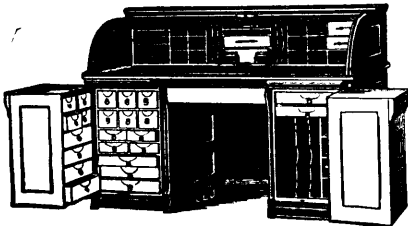

A portion of the land is within two miles of the lake and a half mile north of a station on the Detroit River and Lake Erie Railway.
