- (a) in circumstances in which it would not be practicable to carry out sur veillance with sufficient thoroughness; or
- (b) if the risk of the introduction of infection into the country is considered to be exceptionally accident to be exceptionally serious; or
- (c) if the person who would be subject to surveillance cannot furnish adequate sanitary quarantees adequate sanitary guarantees.

Persons under observation or surveillance shall submit themselves to and examination which the competent sanitary authority may consider necessary.
