There has been a good deal of redistribution of both men and women in this group during the period under review. Apart from the increase at the 3 level, there is now a woman at the 4 level and another at the 7 level. The latter is the first PE to be a Director of a Division in this Department, one of the results of the re-organization of Personnel Bureau.

Not reflected in the statistics are the subsequent promotions of two women: one from 2 to 3 and another from 3 to 4. There is a further woman acting as a PE-4.

Two women in this group earn over \$27,500 per year.

Programme Administration Group, Page 57

The size of this group has been increased by three women, two of them on secondment at the 5 and 6 levels. Both earn over \$27,500 per annum.
