Indonesia Universities Development Project is designed to improve Indonesia's human resource base through development of basic science. The Co-operation in Financial Sector Reform project helps to develop the pensions, insurance and non-tax revenue sectors.

CIDA's Industrial Co-operation Program supports Canadian firms seeking mutually beneficial, long-term business linkages in Indonesia. INC shares up to 80 per cent of the eligible costs incurred by a Canadian company for its activities that have a positive developmental impact, such as technical and economic viability studies, specialized training, transfer of technology and expertise, environment and social or gender impact assessments. Over the years, contributions totalling \$30.2 million have been approved. INC has 43 active projects in Indonesia.
