- Students do not necessarily have to leave the territory to get a Canadian education: within Hong Kong, a number of secondary schools use curricula approved by Canadian provincial education departments. The Canadian International School opened in 1991 and offers a Canadian-based curriculum from grades one to six.
- Educational links are further strengthened by student exchange programs between a number of Canadian and Hong Kong universities as well as scholarship and distance education programs.
- The growing tide of Canadian-educated people in Hong Kong returning to work in the territory has led to a blossoming of Canada-Hong Kong academic and alumni associations. There are an estimated 70 000 graduates living in Hong Kong. Currently, there are 17 alumni associations, including the umbrella Canadian University Association.
