

Mr. David Wright (43), born in Montreal, Quebec, as Minister in Paris.

Mr. Wright [B.Sc. (Mathematics and Economics), McGill University, 1966; M.B.A. (International Finance), Columbia University, 1968] joined the Trade Commissioner Service, Department of Industry, Trade and Commerce in 1968. He transferred to the Department of External Affairs in 1974. He has served abroad in Rome; as First Secretary, Permanent Mission of Canada to the United Nations in New York from 1972 to 1975; and as Counsellor (Economic) in Tokyo from 1978 to 1982. In Ottawa he has held several positions in the Economic Bureau; he was Director of Cabinet Liaison, and Secretary to the Committee of Deputy Ministers on Foreign and Defence Policy from 1982 to 1984; and Director, Economic and Trade Analysis from 1984 to 1985. He has been Director General of Economic Policy since 1985. Mr. Wright replaces Mr. F. Bild.
