FAREWELL VISIT OF NATO SECRETARY GENERAL LORD CARRINGTON

8-10 MARCH 1988

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Right Honourable Joe Clark, announced today that the Right Honourable Lord Carrington, Secretary General of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization, will be making a farewell visit to Canada from March 8-10, 1988.

In Ottawa, Lord Carrington will call upon the Prime Minister, the Right Honourable Brian Mulroney, and the Secretary of State for External Affairs.

In Toronto, the Secretary General will meet with the Minister of Defence, the Honourable Perrin Beatty, and will address the Empire Club.

The Secretary General will also have the opportunity to meet with the Right Honourable John Turner, Leader of the Opposition, and the Honourable Ed Broadbent, Leader of the New Democratic Party.

Lord Carrington is completing a four-year mandate and will be replaced in the capacity of Secretary General by Dr. Manfred Woerner, currently Minister of Defence of the Federal Republic of Germany.
