MCDUGALL TO ADDRESS ASSOCIATION FOR CANADIAN STUDIES IN THE UNITED STATES

The Secretary of State for External Affairs, the Honourable Barbara McDougall, today announced that she will address the Association for Canadian Studies in the United States (ACSUS) on Thursday, November 21, 1991.

ACSUS represents over 700 American scholars engaged in teaching and research on Canada. Mrs. McDougall will speak at a meeting in Boston marking the body's 20th anniversary.

"In just 20 years, the members of ACSUS have generated a great store of scholarship and expertise on Canada," said Mrs. McDougall. "Canadian Studies provide us with a very useful and interesting mirror on ourselves."

More than 20,000 students take academic courses on Canada in the United States. American colleges and universities also boast over 50 Centres for Canadian Studies.
