PRAYERS.

Bill C-36, An Act to amend the War Service Grants Act, was read the third time and passed.

Bill C-37, An Act to amend the Veterans Insurance Act, was read the third time and passed.

The Order being read for the second reading of Bill C-63, An Act respecting the Construction of a line of railway in the Province of Alberta by Canadian National Railway Company from Whitecourt, Alberta, in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 23.2 miles to the property of Pan American Petroleum Corporation;

Mr. Balcer, seconded by Mr. Churchill, moved,—That the said bill be now read a second time.

After debate thereon, the question being put on the said motion, it was agreed to.

Accordingly, the said bill was read the second time and referred to the Standing Committee on Railways, Canals and Telegraph Lines.

By unanimous consent, it was ordered that, when the above-mentioned bill has been reported back to the House by the Standing Committee on Railways, Canals and Telegraph Lines, the Address Debate, if then in progress, shall be interrupted to consider this bill in Committee of the Whole and the third reading thereof.
