PROCLAMATION

W HEREAS Our Parliament of Canada stands prorogued till the fifteenth day of the month of August, 1932, at which time at Our City of Ottawa, you were held and constrained to appear. Nevertheless, for certain causes and considerations, We do Will, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council for Canada, that you and each of you, be as to Us in this matter entirely exonerated, Commanding, and by the tenor of these Presents enjoining you, and each of you, and all others in this behalf interested, that on Saturday, the twentyfourth day of the month of September next, 1932, at Our City of Ottawa, aforesaid, personally you be and appear, for the Despatch of Business, to treat, do, act and conclude upon these things which in Our said Parliament of Canada, by the Common Council of Our said Dominion, may by the favour of God be ordained.

- IN TESTIMONY WHEREOF, We have caused these Our Letters to be made Patent and the Great Seal of Canada to be hereunto affixed. WITNESS: The Right Honourable LYMAN POORE DUFF, One of the Judges of the Supreme Court of Canada and Deputy of Our Right Trusty and Right Well-beloved Cousin and Counsellor, Vere Brabazon, Earl of Bessborough, a Member of Our Most Honourable Privy Council, Knight Grand Cross of Our Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, formerly Captain in Our Territorial Army, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Our Dominion of Canada.
- AT OUR GOVERNMENT HOUSE, in Our City of Ottawa, in Our said Dominion, this eighteenth day of August, in the year of Our Lord one thousand nine hundred and thirty-two and in the twenty-third year of Our Reign.
