Have any meetings been held by the Canadian-Soviet Friendship League in the auditorium of the National Research Council building during the years 1944, 1945, and 1946?

2. If so, how many and on what dates?

3. What was the subject of discussion at each of these meetings, and who presided?

4. Was there any charge for the use of the auditorium for these meetings? If so, what charges were made for each meeting and to whom was the money paid?

5. What was the name of the individual who applied for the use of the auditorium on each occasion?

6. What is the name of the official or officials responsible for renting the auditorium to the above-mentioned organization?
