

By Mr. Benidickson:—Order of the House for a copy of all letters, telegrams, memoranda and other documents exchanged between the Postmaster General, officials of the Post Office Department, the Civil Service Commission or any official thereof and any person, persons or groups of persons, since January 1, 1946, with respect to: (a) the appointment of a postmaster, a postal supervisor or principal clerk for the Kenora, Ontario, Post Office; (b) the grading and staff establishment and salary schedules of the Dryden, Ontario, Post Office.

By Mr. Black (Yukon):—Order of the House for a copy of the contract or contracts under which roads are being built between Minto and Mayo and between Minto and coal mine at Tantlus Bute, all in Yukon Territory.
