4-YEAR CURRICUIUM IN COMMERCE FIRST YOAR (a) Obligatory subjects English, 1. (embracing English Literature and English Composition, with special conference work, where the students are taken in sections.) 2. Mathematics. ( Geometry, Trigonometry and Algebra, most importance being given to Algebra); or ( in case of students taking up Actuarial course in 4th year) Honour course in Mathematics). 3. French or Spanish, or German ( embracing Literature and Composition, with practice in reading and dictation) Accountancy. ( principles and development; books of original record, and documents to be used in connection with them; single entry; double entry; subsidiary ledgers and controlling accounts; notes, drafts, and renewals; capital and revenue expenditure; income-statement and balance-sheet; single proprietorship and partnerships. Demonstration work in all this matter.) (b) Two of the following to be chosen

- 5. Latin or Greek,
  - ( students desirous of proceeding later to degree of B.A. might take one of these)
- German, or Spanish, or French 6.
- 7. Physics or Biology or Chemistry
  - ( meant to impart an elementary knowledge of science and scientific methods)
- 8. General History,
  - ( intended for general culture as well as to throw light on modern literature courses, and courses in Economics )
