Colonel Herbert Molson - 2 is not in accordance with the facts, and that I would take such a stand was known to the Medical Board of the Montreal General Hospital from my letter of October 5th, 1921 and from my letter of October 31st. 1921, both of which were in their possession before this momorandum was prepared. I would be glad to shew you all other correspondence with reference to this matter, but I think I have given you enough to justify my statement that the memorandum set before your Board is unfair and misleading and I would like you to set these facts before your Roard. Personally, I do not wish to enter into any further controversy over what we might call the Mcweil matter. Yours faithfully, Principal.
