

"Efficiency" shall mean, in the case of a commissioned officer, one in good standing in his corps; in the case of a N. C. O. or private, one who has attended and performed at least twelve (12) regular parades of his corps since the 1st January, 1895, or not less than fifty per cent. of drills ordered.

SIGHTING SHOTS. One sighting shot will be allowed at each range; tickets 10 cents each.

CHALLENGES. Any competitor challenging a shot must deposit the sum of fifty cents with the Range Officer, which shall be forfeited if after examination no shot is found in the target.

In cases not provided for as above, the R. A. Rules for 1894 shall be followed.

The Council reserve the right to make changes in the published Prize List or Regulations that may be considered advisable, due notice of any change will be posted on the notice board.

Tents and blankets will be provided on the range for the use of competitors.
