"Efficiency" shall mean, in the case commissioned officer, one in good standing his corps; in the case of a N. C. O. or private one who has attended and performed at a twelve (12) regular parades of his corps in the 1st January, 1895, or not less than fifty cent. of drills ordered.

SIGHTING SHOTS. One sighting will be allowed at each range; tickets 10 a each.

CHALLENGES. Any competitor challed ing a shot must deposit the sum of fifty a with the Range Officer, which shall be for ed if after examination no shot is found the target.

In cases not provided for as above, the R. A. Rules for 1894 shall be followed.
