IN WITNESS whereof, I have signed these Presents, and caused the Seal of the Province to be hereunto affixed; at Halifax, this Thirteenth Day of May, in the Twenty-fourth Year of the Reign of our Sovereign Lord GEORGE the Third, by the Grace of God, of Great-Britain, France and Ireland, KING, Defender of the Faith, and so forth, and in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Eighty-four.
