

Mañana por la noche.
To-morrow by the night.

Mañana por la tarde.
To-morrow by the evening.

Mañana por la mañana.
To-morrow by the morning.

It will be seen that *Por* means *by* and *for*. *Para* means *for* in the sense of *for the benefit of* or *for the purpose of*, whereas *Por* has more the meaning of *in place of*, without any idea of benefit or purpose.

¿Cuyo es este libro? — De mi madre.
Whose is this book? Of my mother (my mother's).
