CHICAGO OPTIONS CHEAPER

Despite Expected Decrease in Visible Supply.

Farmers' Deliveries Still Small, but Big Receipts are Looked for Shortly—European Crop—Pacific Slope Yield—Cheese Shipments—Cassals.

Chicago corn eased off nearly 1c in sympathy with wheat. The market expected large receipts. The futures remained unchanged.

Wheat crop in Europe. The reports are rather conflicting. With respect to the Russian crop, private cables to Chicago say that yield is disappointing.

Cheese exports and prices. The combined exports of cheese from Montreal and New York for the season up to the close of last week were 24,000 boxes less than those of the same period last year.

Grain and produce. Flour—Straight rollers from new wheat, in barrels, miller's freight, are quoted at \$3.10 to \$3.15.
