CHICAGO OPTIENS CHEAPER

Despite Expected Decrease in Visible
Supply.

Farmers' Deliveries Still Small,
but Big Receipts Are Looked For
Shortly—European Crop—Pacific
Slope Yield—Cheese Shipments—
Gossip.

Friday Evening, Aug. 19.
Farmers' deliveries of new wheat con-
tinue very small, and next Monday's sta-
tistics are expected to show a decrease
for the current week of over 1,000,000 bushels
in the visible supply in Canada and the
United States. Nevertheless, with the pros-
pects of very large shipments to market
later in the season, the market exhibits
the August delivery received 1 1/2c, and the
September and December options 1 1/2c and
1c, respectively. The close was at about
bottom quotations.

On the Liverpool board to-day spot wheat
declined 1/4 to 1/2 cent, while the
September and December futures delivered
advanced 1/4 and 3/8 cent, respectively.
Paris futures closed 3 centimes lower
to 15 centimes higher for the day.

Chicago crop eased off nearly 1c in sym-
pathy with the Liverpool market, and ex-
pected large receipts. Spot maize fell off
at Liverpool, but the futures remained un-
changed.

A good foreign demand advanced the Chi-
cago produce market.

Flour declined 1/2 in Liverpool to-day.
Minnesota threshing returns show satis-
factory yields of wheat, barley and oats.
The Minneapolis Market Record says that
the movement of new spring wheat is ex-
pected to increase quite rapidly—more rap-
idly than last year. The receipts of the
new crop are not much different from last
year, and large early deliveries are antici-
pated because the premium for cash wheat
is much greater than usual.

Modern Miller says: Continued falling
off of wheat receipts in primary markets
indicates small marketings by the farmers
and receipts for milling purposes are still
unsatisfactory in quantity and quality. The
demand in general shows little or no
change from last week.

Argentine wheat shipments this week
none, against none last week. Corn ship-
ments to United Kingdom and Continent, 620,000
bushels, against 600,000 last week. Wheat
and 1,200 bushels same week last year.

Total clearances to-day: Wheat and
flour, 67,000 bushels; corn, 44,000 bushels.
Receipts of wheat in Liverpool past three
days, 154,000 cwt., including 34,000 cen-
tals American. Corn same time, 150,800
centals American.

Argentine cables: Wheat market is dull,
with the demand light. Wheat and corn,
quality generally good. Prices for wheat
districts are generally favorable.

St. Louis receipts of wheat to-day, 50,000
bushels, against 100,000 bushels same day
last year.

Corn lots at Chicago to-day were: Wheat
121, contract 2; corn 546, contract 294; oats
538, contract 25.

Primary receipts of wheat to-day, 538,000
bushels, against 512,000 bushels same day
last year. Primary shipments, 315,000
bushels, against 384,000 bushels.

Wheat Crop in Europe.
The reports are rather conflicting. With
respect to the Russian crop, private cable
to Chicago says that yield is disappointing
and condition poor. On same day a cable
from Antwerp advised that the Russian
wheat crop in Russia.

Another cable says: "Offerings very small
and prices are still lower than expected."
"Harvest going on day and night in Russia,
and this year's yield is expected to be
very small. New mills are being constructed
and farm implements are in active demand."

Pacific Coast Wheat.
The San Francisco Commercial News says
that the wheat crop on Pacific Coast is
turning out better than was expected. It
is now admitted that Oregon, Washington
and Idaho will harvest 1,100,000 tons at
least, and that some good authorities add
150,000 tons to this quantity. The smaller
quantity is about the same as the average
for the past few years. The government
news says that the increase in these three
States will balance the deficit in the
Northwest, where the crop is proving rather
better than expected.

Cheese Exports and Prices.
The combined exports of cheese from
Montreal and New York for the season up
to the close of last week were 24,000
boxes less than those of the same period
last year, as shown by the following state-
ment:

A special London cable to the Montreal
Trade Bulletin yesterday stated: "Under
an increased conservative demand, the mar-
ket has developed greater firmness, and
prices have moved up 15 per cent. More
attention is now given to Canadian cheese,
and some large sales have transpired at
the advance. Finest Canadian quoted at
45c to 47c, and good fine at 43c to 45c.
Export market at 30c to 40c for best, and
37c to 39c for good to fine."
