## MINING IN BOUNDARY, B. C.

Statistics Showing That \$4,400,000

Has Been Spent in Development

in That Section.

OVER 600 MEN ARE EMPLOYED

War Eagle and Centre Star Firm—

Sales of Stocks Yesterday—

Change Quotations.

The Board of Trade of Greenwood, B.C.,

has just issued its annual report containing

important information regarding the Boundary

Creek country, which is just on the

verge of revealing its wealth to the world.

The district has been under development

for two years now, and with the advent of

the C.P.R.'s Columbia and Western Rail

way the beginning of the period of pro-

duction has been hastened.

The report shows that there has been

spent in actual development on the

properties of the district the sum of \$4,400,000.

Told has been divided among the camps of

the district as follows:

Skylark and Providence camps—\$1,350,000

Greenwood and Wellington camps—1,400,000

Central camp—575,000

Copper and Kimberley camps—40,000

Long Lake camp—25,000

Summit camp—250,000

Greenwood and Grand Forks—400,000

The report goes on to point out that the

C.P.R. will soon begin to reap its reward

for the construction of the C. & W. on

which it expended the sum of \$7,000,000.

It will have an immense tonnage

of ore going to the mills, and the

Trail smelter and later to the Mother

Loke smelter.

After commenting on the fact that the

year 1899 was a very prosperous one for

Greenwood and the surrounding country,

the report says that the mining industry

has suffered temporary depression owing

to the war in South Africa, the labor

scarcity and the closing down of the War

Eagle and Le Roi. This combination of

circumstances has shattered the confidence

of the public in mining, but this will be

restored shortly by the handsome returns

soon to be actually produced by the mines

which have arrived at a shipping base.

The report then goes on to deal with

each of the deep mining camps within a

radius of eight miles of Greenwood. Of

these there are five, upon which a great

deal of money has been spent, viz., Dead

wood, Greenwood, Summit, Wellington and

Central. The following figures show the

amount of development work accom-
