ITS BIG GAME AND FISH
WORTH \$5,000,000 A YEAR

That Is How Maine Figures It Out—One Man Put at Three
Times as Much, but Overshot the Mark—Value of Protection.

(Bangor Commercial).
The big game season is open or about to open in all the states and territories of the union and in the provinces of Canada. The killing of this kind of game means the expenditure of many millions of dollars in the United States by sportsmen.

Every year, more and more money is spent in this way. Every state in the union has begun to recognize that the preservation of big game in its borders is a source of wealth and all have some kind of protective game law in operation.

The state of Maine has the widest game protective law, according to many authors. Its game resources are regarded as an asset worth to the commonwealth, according to competent judges, from \$5,000,000 to \$8,000,000 a year. Hunting is really one of the great industries of Maine.

What the influx of summer boarders means to many other states is the arrival of big game hunters means to Maine. Through the legislation which has preserved the game and which protects it one of the most fruitful sources of wealth to the state has been conserved.

What is true of Maine is true of practically every other commonwealth in the United States. New York state, where millions of dollars are spent in the pursuit of game every year, New York state estimates that its game resources are worth to the state \$5,000,000 a year. When the hunter arrives in Maine from the outside then his presence becomes an asset. He has to pay railroad fares in the first place. Probably 2,000 licenses to hunt are issued in Maine this year.

Assuming that these hunters will spend \$10 each in Maine for railroad fares, there is a little item of \$20,000 alone. But with the non-residents there will probably be \$100,000 more. Suppose these pay \$5 in railroad fare on each on an average. There is another item of \$100,000.

Every non-resident hunter is required by law to employ a licensed guide. In 1904 there were 2,000 of these guides. They get \$3 a day for their services. They will work altogether about 30 days each. That makes \$180,000 on the average about 50 days each. This means an expenditure of \$900,000.
