QUEBEC CASE UP

Railway Commission Due to Hear Eastern Arguments After Western

OTTAWA, Feb. 8.—Some time this week an announcement is expected from the Dominion Railway Board fixing the date for the hearing of the application of the Quebec interests regarding the carriage of grain over the National Transcontinental to that port.

GRAIN EXPORTS VIA U. S.

Maritime ports were not receiving their fair share of the grain trade. From sixty to seventy per cent. of Canadian wheat was exported through United States channels and the balance through Canadian ports.
