The following recipes are put in with the hope that they will prove of service and make this page one to be looked forward to each Friday.

Nut Cakes
Nuts
2 Potatoes
Egg
Salt
Grind nuts small, boil potatoes in salted water, beat egg, let cool, mix together and form into balls and fry in hot fat. (Best when done with salted peanuts. Sage or savory can be added if desired.)
Meat Pie
Cut meat into small pieces. Peel and slice potatoes, boil until done; do same with vegetables; put in baking dish.
Make a gravy of spoonful of fat or shortening browned with flour. Pour a little water over it, season and let simmer for about 5 minutes; pour over contents of dish. Cover with pastry and bake in hot oven till browned.
Snow Pudding
Soak a half package of gelatine in cold water until dissolved; add 1 pt. boiling water; separate whites of 4 eggs; beat till stiff; add juice of two lemons to gelatine; beat all together until foamy. Serve cold with custard sauce.
Sponge Ginger Bread
Half cup shortening
1 egg
1 tsp. ginger
Half tsp. cloves
Half tsp. cinnamon
Half tsp. salt
2 cups flour
Half cup molasses
Half cup brown sugar
1 cup boiling water
1 tsp. soda
Beat sugar molasses and butter to a cream. Add spices and seasoning. Dissolve soda in cup of boiling water; add beaten egg, soda and flour until this batter. Bake ¾ hour in quick oven.
Tea Room Salad
1 quart cranberries
1 cup Sun Maid seeded raisins.
Water to cover
Half cup sugar
Half tsp. cloves
Half tsp. cinnamon
Juice of a lemon
Half teaspoon granulated gelatine, dissolved in a little water and melted over hot water.
Shredded lettuce.
Cream.
Cook until tender cranberries and seeded raisins in enough water to cover. Rub through sieve; add balance of ingredients, except lettuce and cream. Pour in small wet moulds and place in ice box to harden.
Unmold on bed of shredded lettuce and place spoonful of whipped cream on each. Serve with lemon or French dressing.
Quick Chocolate Frosting
2 squares unsweetened chocolate.
2 tbsps. hot water.
1½ cups powdered sugar.
Half tsp. vanilla.
Half cup chopped Sunmaid raisins.
Melt chocolate and add water; add powdered sugar slowly, beating constantly; add vanilla and raisins and spread.
Oyster Stew
Milk
Oysters
Butter
Salt
Bring milk to boil, add seasoning and oysters. Simmer for 8 or 4 minutes; serve with crackers.
