

VILLAGE OF FORDWICH,

A station on the Toronto, Grey and Bruce Railway, in the Township of Howick, sixty miles from Goderich, contains two hotels, four general stores, two shoe shops, two blacksmith shops, 1 tailor shop, one harness shop, two grist mills, two saw mills, one doctor. Parker's Hotel is very well kept.

VILLAGE OF MANCHESTER,

Partly in the Township of Hullett and Wawanosh, on the gravel road leading from Goderich to Wingham, twelve miles from Goderich, contains two stores, one hotel, two shoe shops, two blacksmith shops, one carriage factory, one cabinet shop, one tannery, one grist mill, one saw mill, one heading and shingle mill, one cheese factory. This village is in the centre of a first-class agricultural district, and has the advantages of first-class water power.

VILLAGE OF NILE,

On the gravel road leading from Goderich to Lucknow, nine miles from Goderich. Commercial men and others will find excellent accommodation at Shephard Jones Hotel.

VILLAGE OF PORT ALBERT,

In the Township of Ashfield, on the gravel road leading from Goderich to Kincardine, twelve miles from Goderich, contains two hotels, two stores, one shoemaker, two blacksmiths, one wheel-right, one grist mill, one saw mill, one stave and shingle factory.

VILLAGE OF VARNA.

A village in the Township of Stanley, eighteen miles from Goderich, on the gravel road leading from Seaforth to Bayfield, contains one hotel, two general stores, one grocery, two blacksmith shops, one waggon shop, one cooper and jobbing shop, one shoe shop, 1 cabinet maker, two grist mills, two saw mills, one butcher shop. A tailor is very much needed here. The Farmers' Inn, kept by John Turner, is the only hotel in the place. The proprietor is very obliging.

VILLAGE OF ZURICH.

The village of Zurich, in the township of Hay, twenty-two miles from Goderich, contains four general stores, two hotels, two shoe shops, one tailor, three blacksmith shops, three waggon makers, two stove and tin shops, two harness shops, one watch maker, one photographer, one butcher shop, one grist mill, one saw mill, one planing and furniture shop, one carding mill, one tannery. N. Duchart keeps a first-class hotel and is very accommodating.
