## BRITISH RAILWAY WORKERS MUST CARRY OUT ORDERS

N. U. R. Will Not Endorse Action of Members in Refusing to Handle Munitions.

A campaign by the friends of "Direct Action" has been carried on in Great Britain enticing the railway workers to refuse to handle munitions for Poland and Ireland. The executive council of the National Railway Workers Union have ruled that the members of that organization must carry out the orders of the railway operators. J. H. Thomas, M.P., the general secretary of the N. U. R., in speaking at Battersea on June 6, said that when first the question of direct action was introduced, he took his stand unhesitatingly against it. It would be ruinous and he felt that it would lead to consequences which would in the end be disastrous to the worker. He refused to subscribe to a policy which said to the worker, "Here is a method by which you can obtain, by striking, something which you have not the intelligence to get through the ballot-box."

The same people who were condemning the railway boycott were the people who during the war were congratulating the seamen for refusing to carry trade union leaders. If it was wrong for them to carry munitions then it was wrong for others to make munitions. (Cheers.) People who said it was wrong for the railwaymen to carry munitions should prevent the making of munitions, for if the munitions were not made railwaymen would not have to carry them.

They had been faced with the fact of 400 men out in Ireland and with the closing of Holyhead. The Prime Minister had said that action of that kind was a war on the community and would be met with every force at their disposal.

Any man who had visited Ireland and had been outside Montjoy, as he had been, would know that we were on the brink of a disaster in that country.

"We cannot, and will not," said Mr. Thomas, "endorse the murders of innocent soldiers or policemen doing their duty. Whether it be a Coalition Labor Government, the responsibility for defending those charged with a difficult task is one that must be accepted by any Government worthy of the name. (Cheers.)"

## GT. BRITAIN TO EXTEND MEDICAL SCIENCE.

Proposals to establish a national medical service whereby the public would have ready access to the resources of modern medical science, are contained in a report issued recently by the consultative council of medical and allied services of Great Britain.

It is stated that the present organization of medicine has failed to bring the advantages of medical science within reach of the people, and that a full state medical service is inadvisable. It is therefore proposed to establish: First—Primary health centres in each populous district for curative and preventive work. Cottage hospitals could be adopted.

Second—Secondary centers in each large town (with big central hospitals as nucleus) for care and consultation upon special cases.

Third—A new type of local health wards with a medical advisory service.

The treatment would be open though not necessarily free, to all classes of the community. It is agreed that doctors should continue attending their own patients at their own homes or at their surgeries, but this system should be brought into relationship with a primary health centre, having wards for various purposes, including provision for midwifery, an operating room, a laboratory for simple investigations, a dispensary, medical baths and a meeting place for the general practitioners of the district and for the storage of clinical records on an agreed and standardized basis.

In North Kensington the housing conditions are as bad as in any part of East London, and it was found that daily treatment of the sick babies at the Telford road Clinic was negated by the shocking conditions of home life to which they were obliged to return. The present premises have been informally open since October last.
