

judgment the applicant is eligible for membership and ought to be admitted as a member of the Association and a two-thirds majority vote of the Executive Committee present to the effect is passed; or if no objection is raised within 90 days of application being received, notice having been given to the Executive Committee, then his name shall be entered on the records as a member, and the Secretary shall issue a certificate of membership. He shall pay non-members registration fees, and when accepted as a member the amount overpaid as a non-member shall be refunded.

SEC. 3. Any member of the Association may at any time withdraw and terminate his membership by returning his certificate of membership to the Secretary, with a letter expressing his wish and intention to terminate his membership.

SEC. 4. Any member of this Association who shall be found guilty of any misrepresentation, deception, or fraud in relation to the registry of animals in the Holstein-Friesian Herd Book shall forfeit his membership in the Association and shall be debarred from further registry.

SEC. 5. Each member of the Association shall be entitled to one copy of the first volume of the Herd Book at half the actual cost price, and non-members may have it at cost price. It shall be forwarded, on receipt of the money to any address.

ARTICLE IV.—OF THE OFFICERS.

SEC. 1. The officers of this Association shall consist of a President and four Vice-Presidents—to be designated as first, second, third and fourth; one Secretary-Treasurer; four Directors, who shall constitute the Executive Committee of this Association. There shall be two Directors elected at the first meeting for the term of one year, and two for the term of two years. In the event of an office becoming vacant the Executive Committee shall have the power to fill such vacancies until the next general election. The Executive Committee shall appoint Inspectors of Imported Cattle, with power to remove for cause and to fill vacancies.
