

The killing of a hundred or more persons—possibly 175—of whom twelve were children and two women, in the Southern Colorado coal fields results from the fight begun last October by the miners' union against the owners. This fight has progressed step by step until a state of armed warfare exists, with the State militia indicted as a confederate of the mine owners.
