Harding Summons Advisory Board To Study U. S. Policy

Washington, Nov. 8.—The advisory committee of twenty-one selected by President Harding to act with the American Big Four at the armament conference will be assembled in Washington three days in advance of the conference opening to give its opinion on the first steps of policy to be taken by this Government.

A call for a meeting of the committee on next Wednesday, November B, was issued today by Secretary Hughes, and at the same time it was revealed that high officials expect the committee members to play an influential part in shaping the Government's course from the beginning to the end of the negotiations.

It is assumed that at the first meeting the committee will be advised tally of the plan for armament reduction drawn up by the four principal delegates and invited to make suggestions on every pertanent subject. As the negotiations develop it is expected by Administration officials that the advisory body will be asked to give its verdict on every point of major importance.
