# NOTICE

### HOW TO FIND US

Room 35 is on the ground floor level of the office wing, that part of the SUB which faces the side of the Harriet Irving Library. The easiest way to get there is to enter through the door over the "tunnel" which leads into the office wing. Once you're inside, go through the fire door directly in front of you and it's the first office on the left.

If you enter through the door of the SUB by the traffic circle, just go left, then right down the corridor, then the first left after that and you're in the office wing. Go down the short steps, proceed to the end of the hall, down those steps to the ground floor, then through the fire door and you're the first office on the left.

If you enter the SUB by the door facing the center of the campus, simply proceed through the next set of metal-and-glass doors, turn the corner and pass the washrooms, through the doors and you're the last office on the right.

deadline here is 1:30 p.m. Tuesday.

Copy for classified ads and upcomin' should be typed or printed clearly, and dropped off in the appropriate baskets by the main door to the Brunswickan office, room 35, Student Union Building.

The Brunswickan welcomes submissions of all types. Clubs and organizations are encouraged to submit news of what's happening with their group.
