over twenty-two years behind them had certainly been there too long but I don't think that the enormous majority of the present Government is a good thing. It did a good deal to paralyze its immediate predecessor. Now I see by to-day's reports that Manitoba has gone Conservative after nearly a generation of a Party calling themselves Liberal Progressive, whatever that means. Naturally at my age I am not worrying over the matter at all and with a few tranquilizers which I take it keeps me on an even keel so that I don't have a minute's worry as to who is in power. The way they are throwing around not millions but billions and have been ever since the war should give one something to thin k seriously about.

I have no doubt you are taking these matters philosophically yourself.

I trust you are keeping as well as you look and that all goes well.
