Rt. Rev. Sir:-

I am directed by the Superintendent General of Indian Affairs to acknowledge the receipt of Your Lordship's letter to him of the 13th ultimo, which the absence of the Superintendent General from Ottawa until recently prevented being acknowledged previously.

I am to inform Your Lordship, with respect to the subject matter of the said letter, viz., the proposed increased grant for the Industrial School at Wikwemikong, that the Superintendent General, having given consideration to the claims of the Wikwemikong Institution to an augmentation in the amount annually paid it by this Department, has decided that he will recommend to the Hon. the Privy Council that the grant be increased from \$1,800 to \$2,300 per annum; and should the Superintendent General's colleagues agree to this increase being granted, he will include the same in the Estimates to be submitted to Parliament at the ensuing session, and should Parliament vote the amount, the increase will be payable from
