
Ottawa 25th November 1901-

Sir,

In reply to your letter of the 18th Instant, enclosing an agreement between Mr.D.A. McCorkindale and Xavier Nadjiwon, to lease to the former the house on Lot 35, Con. 3, Cape Croker Reserve for the sum of \$1.50 per month, also room in stable for a span of horses, for a term of 2 years, I have to inform you that on your advising the Department of the date from which Mr. McCorkindale took possession of the house the agreement will be accepted and entered in the Books of the Department. Under the circumstances the agreement is considered sufficient and no lease will be issued.

The rental should be paid to you and forwarded to the Department together with a requisition for the amount in favour of the Locatee.
