
With reference to your letter of the 9th instant, I beg to say that the Department approves of your purchasing a second hand cook stove for the Indian Peter Toney. It is observed that you state the cost will be about \$7.00 or \$8.00.

You may purchase for the old Indian John Logan a stove, also 1 thousand boards, ~~sixteen~~ one roll of tar paper and 12 lbs nails, the total cost of which you place at \$17.00

For the Indian Abram Jeremy you may purchase the boards and other articles which you mention at a total cost of about \$18.00.

You should see that the building material furnished these Indians is used by them for the purpose for which it is intended.
