Sir,-

With reference to your letter of 15th instant, in regard to the case of small-pox on Walpole Island, I beg to say that the Department wired you as follows:-

"Take all necessary precautions to prevent spread of small-pox. Notify Provincial Board of Health, Toronto, immediately".

You should arrange for necessary supplies being furnished the Indians in quarantine, but no unnecessary expense should be incurred. Kindly ascertain and inform the Department when the Indians of your Agency were vaccinated.
