



Ottawa, 27th January, 1915.

Sir:-

Referring to your letter of the 23rd instant with enclosures, I enclose for your information copy of a letter which the Department is writing to Mr. Logan informing him that the Department has decided to sanction the establishment of a Hospital at Berdina City for the treatment of eye and skin disease with which the Indians of the Roseau River Reserve are afflicted. You will observe that Dr. Houston when furnishing an estimate of cost has placed the same at \$14.75 a day, although he states that the expenditure may possibly be kept lower than that amount. It is desired that you will give Dr. Houston the benefit of your advice, and that you will furnish him with such assistance as is possible in connection with the performance of his work at the Hospital.
