Sir.—

In the course of re-arranging the Office here and compiling new Records, I find that in March 1914, the Department issued Lease No 45, on the Semiahmoo Indian Reserve to the Campbell River Lumber Co, of White Rock, B.C. This Lease was apparently to run for a period of 21 years at an annual rental of \$100.00, but no collections have ever been made through this Office, and we have no knowledge of whether the lease is in good standing or not?

Would you be good enough to inform me, please, whether this Company has been remitting regularly to the Department, and if so, I shall be further obliged for a list of the payments made, in order that my Lease Ledger may be written up to date.

This is apparently the only Lease not kept track of locally, and I would request that this Office be kept informed of payments received in order that the Agency Records may be complete.
