Limitation.

4. The powers conferred by this Act shall remain in force only during the continuation of the state of war now existing.

Tabling of orders and regulations.

5. Every order or regulation passed under the authority of this Act shall be tabled in Parliament forthwith if 5 Parliament is in Session and a copy thereof sent to every Member of the House of Commons and of the Senate and if Parliament is not in Session then every such order or regulation shall be forthwith published in the Canada Gazette and copies thereof sent to every Member of the 10 House of Commons and of the Senate forthwith; provided that any of the steps specified in this section may be omitted or deferred if the Governor in Council considers such omission or deferment necessary in the national interest having regard to the special circumstances.

Imposing penalties.

6. The Governor in Council may prescribe the penalties that may be imposed for violations of orders and regulations made under this Act, and may also prescribe whether such penalties shall be imposed upon summary conviction or upon indictment, but no such penalty shall exceed a fine of 20 five thousand dollars or imprisonment for any term not exceeding five years, or both fine and imprisonment.
