Our policy should be to to be smelted. give the greatest possible freedom in transportation that the greatest possible output of ore may be made available. When that policy opens the prospects of a smelting enterprise, as at Fernie, we must regard it as a piece of additional good fortune. The Clergue enterprises in New Ontario, including railways, pulp mills, mines and smelters, have in prospect a pay-roll of \$10,000 per day. Enterprises as extensive and a payroll as large are in prospect in the Crow's Nest Pass district. How would we like to have the needed railway connections in New Ontario prohibited by British Columbia votes?
