

day read and approved, when the business of the Conference shall proceed in the following order, viz.:—

1. Reports, first of the Standing and then of the Select Committees.
2. Petitions, Memorials, and Appeals.

III.

The President shall decide all questions of order, subject to an appeal to the Conference; but, in case of such appeal, the question shall be taken without debate.

IV.

He shall appoint all Committees, not otherwise specially ordered by the Conference; but any member may decline serving on more than one Committee at the same time.
