Rights and Duties of Miners

Section 19. The forms of application for a grant for placer Grants for mining, and the grant of the same, shall be those contained in mining. forms F and G in the schedule hereto.

Section 20. The entry of every holder of a grant for placer Renewal mining must be renewed, and his receipt relinquished and re-every year. placed every year the entry fee being paid each time.

Section 21. No miner shall receive a grant of more than one Only one mining claim in the same locality, but the same miner may hold granted any number of claims by purchase, and any number of miners in one may unite to work their claims in common upon such terms as locality. they may arrange, provided such agreement be registered with the local agent.

Section 22. Any miner or association of miners may sell, Miner may mortgage, or dispose of his or their claims, provided such dismortgage posal be registered with, and a fee of two dollars paid to the claim. local agent, who shall thereupon give the assignee a certificate in form H in the schedule hereto.

Section 23. Every miner shall, during the continuance of his Exclusive grant, have the exclusive right of entry upon his own claim, for entry the miner-like working thereof, and the construction of a and to residence thereon, and shall be entitled exclusively to all the proceeds, but not to proceeds realized therefrom; but he shall have no surface rights surface. therein; and the local agent may grant to the holders of adjacent claims such right of entry thereon as may be absolutely necessary for the working of their claims, upon such terms as may to him seem reasonable.

Section 24. Every miner shall be entitled to the use of so Use of much of the water naturally flowing through or past his claim, right to and not already lawfully appropriated, as shall, in the opinion drain. of the local agent, be necessary for the due working thereof; and shall be entitled to drain his own claim free of charge.

Section 25. A claim shall be deemed to be abandoned and When claim open to occupation and entry by any person when the same deemed shall have remained unworked on working days by the grantee to be thereof for the space of seventy-two hours, unless sickness or abandoned. thereof for the space of seventy-two hours, unless sickness or other reasonable cause be shown, or unless the grantee is absent on leave.

Section 26. A claim granted under these regulations shall be claim shall be shall be continuously and in good faith worked, except as otherwise pro- worked vided, by the grantee thereof or by some person on his behalf. continuously.

Section 27. In tunnelling under hills on the frontage of which Tunnelling under hills. angles occur, or which may be of an oblong or elliptical form, no party shall be allowed to tunnel from any of the said angles, or from either end of such hills, so as to interfere with parties tunnelling from the main frontage.
