THE FROST & WOOD MOWER

THIS mower has an inside gear drive which keeps in close mesh with the large gear on the main wheel. This power is transmitted to the pitman by roller-bearing shafting. The pitman is extra long.

The result is a very light-draft mower, and a knife that starts instantly. Clogging and choking is prevented, and the knife stands up under the most severe strains.

THE "TIGER" RAKE

THE Frost & Wood "Tiger" Rake is built for great strength, with perfect raking action. To prevent center teeth from sagging, the wider sizes have a truss-rod support under the tooth-bar. The wheels are steel. The foot-trip is a positive-acting cog-device. It gives a high, cleanly-dumped windrow at a touch.



THE FROST & WOOD BINDER


THE "Frost & Wood Binder" stands alone among modern binders. The knotter is driven by an eccentric sprocket, which gives proper leverage for compressing the bundle. The tie and discharge of a sheaf is made without "chug" or slowing down. This means that both the team and binder are saved from strain thereby. In a day's work the team will have covered a greater mileage than with an ordinary machine.

Besides being a speedy harvesting machine, the Frost & Wood Binder is thoroughly economical. The tilting levers and other devices are easily and quickly handled for "down" crop. The elevator canvasses automatically adjust themselves to light or heavy crops. On the deck, the straw is fed to the packers in the best possible condition for making a neat sheaf. 
