BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Act passed in the Seventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty Queen Acts 7 and 8, Vic. Victoria, entitled, An Act for dividing the Township of Pictou into separate Districts for the support of the Poor, except as altered or amended by the Act hereinafter mentioned; and also, the Act passed in the Eighth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, to amend the said first mentioned Act, shall be continued, and the said Acts, and every matter, clause, and thing, therein contained, except as before excepted, are hereby continued for Two Years, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.

CAP. XC.

An Act to continue the Act relating to the gathering of Sea Manure in the County of Halifax.

PE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Act 7, Vic., con-Act passed in the Seventh year of the Reign of Her present Majesty, Queen Victoria, entitled, An Act to authorise the Sessions of the Peace for the County of Halifax to make regulations for the gathering of Sea Manure in the said County, and every matter, clause, and thing therein contained, shall be continued, and the same are hereby continued for Three Years and thence to the end of then the next Session of the General Assembly.

CAP. XCI.

An Act to continue and amend the Acts to Regulate the Pilotage of Vessels at the Port of Halifax.

BE it enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Act passed in the Eleventh year of the Reign of His late Majesty King Acts 11, Geo. 4, 1 and 2, Wm. 4, & gree the Fourth. entitled. An Act to regulate the Pilotage of Vessels at the 8, Vio. continued. George the Fourth, entitled, An Act to regulate the Pilotage of Vessels at the Port of Halifax; and the several Acts passed in the First and Second years, respectively, of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, in amendment of, and additional to, the said Act, except so far as the same may be altered or amended by the Act hereinaster mentioned, or by this Act; and also, the Act passed in the Eighth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, to continue and amend the said Acts, except as altered by this Act, shall be continued, and the said several Acts, and every matter, clause, and thing, therein contained, except as before excepted, are hereby continued for One Year, and thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.
