the said Charles Baptiste Bouc, Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard upon the conviction aforesaid: Whereupon it is considered by the Court here that the said Charles Baptiste Bouc be imprisoned in the common gaol of the faid district, during the space of three calendar months, that he do pay a fine of twenty pounds to our faid Lord the King, and that he do find fecurity for his good behaviour for the space of three years next after his discharge, he the said Charles Baptiste Bouc in the sum of five hundred pounds, and two sureties in the sum of two hundred pounds each, and that the said Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard be severally imprisoned in the said gaol for the space of three weeks, and that they the faid Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard do severally pay a fine of fix shillings and eight pence to our faid Lord the King, which faid Charles Baptiste Bour being prefent here under the custody of the said Sheriff, is fined for the said offence twenty pounds, to the use of our said Lord the King, and the said Charles Baptiste Bouc is committed to the common gaol of the said district, there to remain for the space of three calendar months; and the said Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Coll, Antoine Lauxon, and Magdeleine Collard, being also present here, under the custody of the said Sheriff, are severally fined for the offence aforesaid, fix shillings and eight pence to the use of our said Lord the King; and they the said Charles Renault, Jean Baptiste Coll, Antoine Lauzon, and Magdeleine Collard are severally cominitted to the faid gaol there to remain for the space of three weeks.
