of the Province, which has enabled the Legislature to extend a Prudent Relief to Trade and Navigation, that will Naturally circulate its Benefits to the Encouragement of the Fisheries, with which it is Indispensibly connected; and which has also enabled you to Grant such great Aids to the Agriculture of the Country, and Comfort of the People, in affording them the Means of making Roads and Bridges through very many Parts of the Province, thereby distributing Money for all the Labour that can Possibly be Spared, to an extent, beyond our most sanguine Hopes, but a few Years since.

How thankful then, ought we to be to the Supreme Being, through whose beneficient Providence these Blessings are derived; Health and Plenty are continued to us, and our Country preserved from the Ravages of Merciles Enemies; that the most precious Health of our Gracious Sovereign and all the ROYAL FAMILY is preserved and that His Enemies are Frustrated in their Wicked Attempts, by the affectionate Loyalty and Attachment of His Subjects and the Valour of His Forces by Sea and Land.

These bright Examples you will continue to Cultivate in your different Districts during the Recess; and I trust that whatever Measures may be found necessary, still surther, to promote the Prosperity of the Province, will in due time be ac-

complished.
