The Town Election.

In a very few weeks now we shall be having our civic election for Mayor and Councillors. This is an occasion of more than ordinary interest and should in no way be neglected by the patriotic citizen.

Town Council.

The regular monthly meeting of the Council was held on Wednesday evening with Mayor Chambers in the chair and all the members of the Council present.

The Finance Committee reported receipts during December \$3406.36, and expenditures \$1103.86. The debit bank balance at the end of December was \$1975.29.

The report of Dr. G. E. DeWitt, Health Officer for the past year, was read. The reports of the various standing committees and the report of the Mayor to the Provincial Secretary were read and passed.

The report of the recent installation of a meteorological station here in connection with Acadia University and the need of a light on University avenue in that vicinity. On motion it was decided to place a light as desired.

On motion J. W. Selridge was elected returning officer and A. E. Caldwell poll clerk for the ensuing town election, which takes place on Tuesday, Feb. 4th.

A Great Convention at Halifax.

The annual convention of the salesmen and managers of Brandram-Henderson, Limited, was held at Halifax just before the end of the old year. It was attended by all the firm's representatives east of the Great Lakes, but not by those from farther west.

Previous Sales Conventions held by Brandram-Henderson have always taken place at Montreal, but it was thought well to come to Halifax on the occasion referred to and for several reasons. Many of the Quebec and Ontario travellers had never been in this province, and it was felt that they should have a chance to become acquainted with the progress this section of Canada is making at the present time.

A matter that should be dealt with by the Municipal Council at its annual meeting next week is the provision for prisoners serving sentence in the jail at Kentville being given something to do to earn their board at least. The present system puts a premium upon idleness and crime and is besides very poor business.

Hon. Dr. Roche, Minister of the Interior, has been in receipt of many letters of congratulation in regard to his order in removing the immigration restrictions on Newfoundlanders coming into Canada. Former residents of the ancient colony have particularly appreciated the move of the minister and have written him thanking him for the courtesy he has extended to Newfoundlanders and also expressing the hope that the Borden government may be successful in bringing the island into confederation.

The Dominion of Canada is about 700,000 square miles larger than the United States. The latest area given in Canada is 3,750,000 and the United States, including Alaska, 3,623,328 square miles. Newfoundland, which is not in Canada though in the Empire, adds another 163,100 square miles. The population of the United States ten years ago was fourteen times larger than that of Canada. Last year it was only twelve times larger.

The Summer School of Science for the Maritime Provinces will hold its 27th annual session at Halifax from July 28th to July 31st, 1913. All teachers who can possibly do so should be present.
