Class "C", \$1035. Class "B", \$1092.

Class "A", \$1150, with \$60 added to college graduates.
Under the new scale no gentle-

man teacher in the Halifax academy will receive less than \$2400, the principal will receive, all told, \$3,000. The salary of the headmaster of Bloomfield school will be increased to \$2700; that of the Sister in command of the Catholic school to \$2,000. All ladies in the academy have received cor-
