Russia is building iron-clads at Nikolaieff, on the Black Sea, her fleet at present consisting of a few light-armed corvettes, despatch boats and revenue cutters. Her iron-clads are monitors, called the <i>Novgorod</i> and <i>Kief</i> , the former of which is launched. On these vessels rest the hopes of an efficient Black Sea fleet, but how far they will be successful cannot be estimated owing to their being constructed on an entirely new principle as yet untried. They are designed by Admiral Popoff, and differ from the usual models in having no revolving turrets, but revolving themselves bodily in about their own length.
