TERRIBLE TALE OF THE SEA.

told at Liverpool on Wednesday, when Captain G. C. Oxley, master of the Polish Monarch, of Glasgow, was presented with a silver cup awarded by the King of Norway in recognition of his services to the survivors of the Norwegian barque Sadchama, which foundered in the Atlantic on July 5, 1918. Two boats were launched, and remained in company throughout the day, but in the evening the lookout of Owing to the state of the weather nothing could be done to render assistance. About midnight on July 6 a capsize. The men clung to the boat, and climbed on to the keel. They lay on the bottom for half an hour, and then righted her. They found they had lost one man and nearly all of the equipment and provisions.

On the following day the cook became insane and died. Three days took half an hour to right her. The men lost more provisions, and their 000.00. supply of fresh water was spoilt.

A third time the boat capsized, and everything was lost with the exception of a sail. Then the steward drank salt properties now on our Real Eswater, became insane and died. The tate list to be disposed of:men had been in their open boat for ten days, when they were rescued by the Polish Monarch.


